

## Instructions of abstract for ISAEM-2008

Presenting Author<sup>1</sup>, Co-Authors<sup>2</sup> (ex. M. Morinaga<sup>1</sup> and M. Niinomi<sup>2</sup>)

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**Title:** Type the abstract title in upper and lower case letters (do not use all capitals letters). Title must be bolded and centered (10 points). Use a short, substantive title.

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Please structure your abstract to make it more readable. A typical but not binding structure is: **1. Introduction, 2. Experimental Procedures, 3. Results and Discussion, 4. Conclusions / Summary and References.**

**Figures and Tables:** Figures and Tables should be used when necessary to substantiate results. They must be numbered in the order of their appearance in your text. (ex. Fig. 1, Fig. 2, Table 1 and Table 2)
