

Instructions of abstract for ISAEM-2012

Title: Type the abstract title in upper and lower case letters (do not use all capitals letters). Title must be bolded and centered (10 points). Use a short, substantive title.

Authors: The presenting author's name must be underlined. Type author(s) name(s) and affiliation including city, state/province and country (10 points). Do not use titles; i.e. M.D., Ph.D., etc. Type in upper and lower case type. If the affiliations of the other authors are different from the first author, designate affiliations of other authors.

Abstract Body: Text should be typed single-spaced (10 points). Do not skip a line between paragraphs. Only the fonts listed below are approved for use: Times New Roman and Symbol
Please structure your abstract to make it more readable. A typical but not binding structure is: **1. Introduction, 2. Experimental Procedures, 3. Results and Discussion, 4. Conclusions / Summary and References.**

Figures and Tables: Figures and Tables should be used when necessary to substantiate results. They must be numbered in the order of their appearance in your text. (ex. Fig. 1, Fig. 2, Table 1 and Table 2)

References: References must be numbered in the order of their appearance in your text. The sequential numbers should be placed in brackets as [1], [2,3] or [4-6]. Superscripts should not be used for the reference numbers.

List Journal references as:

ex. [1] S. R. Pati and M. Cohen: Acta Metall. **17**(1969) 189-200.

List Book references as:

ex. [2] W. Hume-Rothery, R. E. Smallman and C. W. Haworth: *The Structure of Metals and Alloys*, (The Metals and Metallurgy Trust of the Institute of Metals and Institution of Metallurgists, London, 1969) pp. 336-342.
